CURRICULUM/SCHOOL OPERATIONS

- A. Budget Update
 - Jon Schleusner presented a slideshow comparing the 24-25 budget categories to today's spending.
- B. School Assessments/Activities

 Jeff Allen spoke about ways the district prepared students for the Forward test. He updated the board about the conversations with Arrowhead and our Middle School teachers.

- C. April Regular/Reorganizational Meeting Date
 The board agreed to revise the meeting date from April 21 to April 30, 2025, at 6:00 p.m.
- D. Liquidated Damages Jon Schleusner provided details about liquidated damages, stating that the reason for the change would be to cover health insurance costs. If the District wishes to implement this change, a modification to the teacher contract will be necessary.
- E. School Water
 - Jon Schleusner updated the Board, letting them know that Guthrie & Frey visited the district and discovered that the system was indicating a constant flow of water. This ongoing issue would prevent the softener from functioning effectively. Maintenance identified the source of the running water and will monitor the situation for two weeks to see if the water quality improves.
- F. Intergovernmental agreement regarding easement between the Town of Merton and Stone Bank School District
 - Jon Schleusner explained that the agreement was reviewed by the school attorney. Board members would like to see the survey attached before granting approval, and they would prefer to change the term to less than 40 years, which is the statute.
